In the article on THz Pioneer Robert J. Mattauch [1], there are several references to the formation of Virginia Diodes (VDI). Associated with all of these references there should be at least one additional person mentioned, Bill Bishop. Bill co-founded the company along with Tom Crowe, in 1996. He served as its first Vice-President and developed much of the THz diode fabrication process [2]. David Porterfield and Jeffrey Hesler also played significant roles in the establishment and growth of VDI, having come on board in 2001. They provided VDI with world class THz circuit design capability. Bill retired from the company in 2010. David Porterfield left to form his own company in 2008. Jeffrey Hesler is still active with Tom in managing and working in the company as its Vice-President and Chief Technical Officer.
