

Memorandum of Understanding Signing Ceremony Between IEEE CTSoc and CTU

WAHAB ALMUHTADI**, IEEE Consumer Technology Society (CTSoc) President 2019–2022, and Mr. Gary Kalloo, Caribbean Telecommunications Union (CTU) Business Development & Implementation Support Director, signed an MoU 1 December 2022, on conclusion of the 2022 CTSoc's Gaming Entertainment and Media Conference held in Bridgetown, Barbados; see Figure 1.

Dr. Almuhtadi stated “Today is a significant day for signing this MoU between IEEE CTSoc and CTU. It is an important cooperation to start fostering activities mutually beneficial to both organizations.”

Representing Mr. Rodney Taylor, Secretary-General of the CTU, Mr. Gary Kalloo indicated,

“The CTU is proud to be associated with the IEEE CTSoc GEM initiative. We believe the CTU can play a substantive role in building awareness and in sensitizing the region as a whole about the opportunities and benefits that can be derived from this relatively new and innovative sector to the region.
