As the Chair of the APEMC 2020 EMC Symposium, I had the unenviable task to recommend to our organizing committee to cancel the symposium in early February this year.

The symposium organization was well advanced with the paper acceptance milestone having been reached. A month previous we were all excited about how smoothly things had progressed but slowly it emerged that trouble was on the horizon.

At the time international travel was still occurring to Australia but signs of the impending disaster were there. In hindsight, it was the correct decision, but it caused tremendous heartache for the organizer and our financial backers, the Australia Institute of Engineers.

As Technical Cosponsor, the IEEE EMC Society supported our decision. The assistance we received from the IEEE EMC Society Board of Directors was commendable, especially from Professor Alistair Duffy, Vignesh Rajamani, and Janet O’Neil.

Our other consideration, given the inevitable difficulty of travelling to the event was informing authors and prospective delegates to alleviate possible difficulties in obtaining refunds for travel and accommodation.

The organizing committee arranged alternative options for authors who had their papers accepted, given they needed to present to be eligible to be published in IEEE Xplore. Most of the authors have been accommodated.

The tremendous efforts of the organizing committee need to be

acknowledged. Working with members in five different time zones was a challenge, but with the wonders of technology and tremendous commitment, a great deal was achieved.
