Program Description

The program will cover all aspects of the clinical application of computer techniques in electrocardiography, Holter-cardiography and exercise-cardiography. In addition, various practical demonstrations will be available to demonstrate the computer techniques in electrocardiography.

General Information

Registration Fees

Program fees are \$200 for members of the American College of Cardiology and \$220 for nonmembers of the College. The fees include a program notebook, luncheons and refreshments, transportation between the hotel and Heart House, and the use of the Griffith Resource Library.

Cancellation

Because of advance planning requirements, full refund will be given only for cancellations received *four weeks in advance of the program*. Following this date, a \$50 processing fee will be charged on cancellations received prior to the program. Exceptions will be considered in view of unusual circumstances. Registrants who fail to attend are responsible for the entire fee unless they contact the Registrar before the program to cancel.

Credit
